- The ARHA Board Meeting was held on January 29th. \The group discussed plans for the May Member Meeting where The Democratic Mayoral Candidates will give brief talks about their platforms.
- Plans for the following Saturday Hearing regarding the Montgomery Street two-way proposal were discussed.
- After the discussion, the President proposed and Board in attendance agreed that NOTICE "endorse and support" the public housing policy articulated in Resolution 830 as its position in final recommendations on the Working Group.
